BAILDON FARMERS MARKET

Baildon Farmers' Market takes place on the fourth Saturday of each month from 9am until 1pm in the lower lan Clough car park.

Every month, shoppers flock from Baildon and further afield for local, seasonal produce. You can buy fresh, locally produced food from fantastic Yorkshire suppliers, including award-winning pies, sour-dough bread, cheese from the Dales and homemade pickles.

You'll find fresh and smoked fish from Whitby, prize-winning honey, herbs, plants and oils, locally grown fruit and vegetables, jams and preserves and venison and game. You'll also see seasonal stalls like strawberries, rhubarb and asparagus.

Baildon Farmers' Market is an event for the whole community. Shoppers get to meet the producers and growers of the food they buy, taste free samples and even buy a Baildon Farmers' Market bag! There's usually live music and fun for the kids with a different bingo trail every month (prizes guaranteed!)

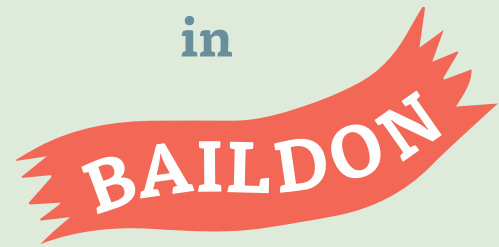

INTRODUCTION TO BAILDON

Stretching from the river at Roberts Park, along Otley Road through Charlestown and Tong Park, and up to Baildon Moor, Baildon is much more than just what is traditionally considered the village.

Around 16,000 residents, spread across an area of approximately 16 square miles, live, work, shop and eat at locations from Charlestown to Baildon Bridge to the Coach Road.

This map and guide focuses on things to do in the centre. However, there are shopping areas spread across our town and many other places to visit further afield.

There's lots to see and do: the Victorian tramway at Shipley Glen runs at weekends and Roberts Park, although part of the Saltaire World Heritage Site, is within the Baildon boundary.

Baildon is lucky to have diversity and a great selection of independent businesses. If you're already familiar with our town, we hope this guide will remind you of all the great opportunities for shopping, eating and fun in the wonderful place where we live! Visitors: we urge you to come along and see the best of what Baildon has to offer!



HISTORY OF BAILDON

Baildon was first inhabited around 5,000 years ago by a small group of hunter-gatherers who left behind flint tools, arrowheads and pottery.

The famous cup and ring markings found across the moor and glen are Bronze Age art, and now scheduled monuments, found in only a few other areas of Britain.

Baildon's first industry was ironstone extraction from the moor, which began in the 14th century. From the early 18th century, a principal source of wealth for Baildon was textile production. Clothiers cottages such as those at Brook Hill, Butler House, Brackenhall and Trench were built at this time.

The textile industry in the Shipley area was mechanised between 1780 and 1830. The first mills were at Baildon Bridge and Tong Park. Towards the end of the 19th century, aided by the opening of the Shipley-Ilkley railway line in 1876, Baildon became a desirable place for the wealthy to live.

Baildon Urban District Council was established in 1895 and met in a building on Westgate. In 1936 the Council moved to Rushcroft Terrace, where it remained until Bradford Metropolitan District Council was set up in 1974. Baildon Town Council (formerly Parish Council) was set up in 2007.
